# Homework/Tests/Quizzes

Homework is usually due the next day and will be graded in class for 10 points. Students have a handout explaining the point system for their homework assignments. Typically, we will have a quiz each week, resulting in several quizzes throughout each quarter. Tests will be given at the conclusion of each chapter and will be worth 100 points. Students are not allowed to use notes or homework on their quizzes or tests, unless otherwise specified. Students may use a calculator on homework, quizzes and tests, unless otherwise specified.
